

Blue Rock Springs Golf Club – Member Policies Addendum

To ensure every golfing experience is of the highest degree of quality, Blue Rock Springs Golf Course asks all members and guests to abide by the following policies. Members or guests violating these policies in excess may be asked to leave the golf course. Please report any violations to the Golf Shop immediately.

1. **Member Guest Rate:** All members will receive a guest punch card (20 uses). The member is responsible for lost or stolen cards and can have **one guest per day**. Guest rate, WEEKDAY \$42, WEEKENDS \$58 (cart included).
2. Members need to check into the golf shop before playing. **MEMBERS MUST CHECK IN THEIR GUEST**. Your guest will no longer be allowed to check in at the Member Guest Rate without the member present with their **GUEST PUNCH CARD**, the posted rate will be charged. REFUND WILL NOT BE ISSUED.
3. No outside food, beverage or coolers allowed on property or in a member's cart (see below).
4. Tee times must be reserved with a valid credit card on file. No-Show and Short-Shows will incur a \$20 per player fee charged to the booking member's credit card on file. Tee times are subject to availability.
 - a. Tee times should be cancelled or adjusted no less than 24-hours in advance of the tee time.
 - b. Members with invalid credit cards will be put on hold until a valid credit card is put on file.
5. **Holiday List:** Blue Rock Springs Golf Course recognizes **ALL** federally observed holidays, Black Friday (Nov. 26) as well as course declared holidays. (See full Holiday List 2027)
6. All members using a golf cart are **ASKED TO PAIR UP AND RIDE TOGETHER**. We do not have enough carts to allow multiple single riders in a group.
7. Blue Rock Springs Golf Course **DOES NOT ALLOW** 5-somes under any circumstance.
8. **Pace of Play Expectations:**
 - a. Early morning play (<10am) should finish 18-holes in 4:10 minutes or less
 - b. Midday play (>10am) should finish 18-holes in 4:30 minutes or less
 - c. For the enjoyment of all players please keep pace with the group in front of you

If you are unable to keep pace you may be asked to pick up and move forward to regain your position on the golf course and help the pace of the golfers behind you
9. COURSE RULES | "ETIQUETTE" – the customary code of polite behavior in society among members of a particular profession or group.
 - a. ALL golfers must abide by designated cart path rules at all times.

- b. Golf carts should remain at least 30 feet away from tees and greens (including ADA blue flags)
- c. **ALL** par 3's are cart path only **AT ALL TIMES**
- d. **NO OUTSIDE COOLERS, FOOD, OR BEVERAGES** – Violation of this will result in loss of playing privileges
 - i. Refusal to surrender these items will result in immediate removal from the golf course
- e. ONLY two people per golf cart and every player **MUST have a set of clubs**. Rental Clubs are available in the Golf Shop
- f. Any person 13 years or younger needs to be accompanied by an adult 21 years or older. **No person under the age of 5 will not be permitted on the course for safety purposes.**
- g. Dress Code: Short and shoes must be worn at all times
- h. You are responsible for any injury to people or damage to property caused by your actions, **including errant golf shots**
- i. Caring for the course by fixing ball marks, sanding divots, and raking bunkers is encouraged. Please be courteous of the players behind you.

As a member of Blue Rock Springs Golf Course, we acknowledge that you have chosen to golf here at your leisure. We encourage you to take full advantage of the privileges of your membership every day. We also expect that you will uphold these policies and embody the spirit of honor and integrity that the game of golf is built upon. Please help us continue to set high standards at Blue Rock Springs Golf Course not just for the golfers of today but the golfers of tomorrow as well.

Any member abusing or breaking club rules will be disciplined, further disciplinary action, your membership may be cancelled and subsequently removed from BRSGC “the club” and the Annual Membership Program.
